- Our services and programs enhance community health and well-being, and reduce costs for criminal justice, child and family services, health care, and other county and nonprofit agencies. Our clients are jail inmates, former inmates, state parolees, and their families.
- Our programs assist in breaking the cycle of addiction in families when we work with parents or expectant mothers.
- Our services ease the burden on the family who suffers because of the loss of income and stability created by the incarceration of a family member.

2008 Highlights

- ❖ *Purchased 2 new transitional Hope Houses for Men, and opened Tim's House.*
- ❖ *Provided childcare during visits by more than 1700 children to the San Mateo County jails.*
- ❖ *Coordinated with 130+ volunteers to meet the spiritual needs of inmates of all faiths with worship services and one-on-one counseling for more than 11,000 attendees.*

Service League Programs & Services

In-Custody Services: Our staff coordinates and delivers services within the various adult correctional facilities in San Mateo County, including those dealing with problem-solving, humanitarian, educational and personal growth.

Release and Re-Entry Services: Our emergency assistance, counseling, referral to other agencies, and employment referral services provide every opportunity for the ex-offender to re-enter the community. We assist these clients to help reduce the re-arrest rate by maintaining sobriety and vocational and job training participation.

Hope Houses - Treatment: Residential programs provide substance abuse treatment for women who have been involved in the criminal justice system. They are referred to our program from either San Mateo County Jail or California Department of Corrections and also on a self-referral basis.

Hope Houses - Transitional Housing: We provide a sober living environments to assist men and women in the difficult transition from custody to the community. This supportive residence is an option for those who have served their jail sentences and have actively participated in educational, social, and recovery programs.
